Guidelines for Costs, Space and Advertising

We'll assist in any way we can to make this a positive and economical experience. The workshops will be captured under events at two web sites and e-marketing newsletters.

70/30: 30% covers facility costs (*lights, heat, ac and training sanctuary, which is a climate controlled, pleasant environment*). We can provide microphone, 8-foot screen, 32 inch flat screen (DVDs) and refreshments. Special requests are considered.

Example: 10 attendees at \$40 = 400. 70% = \$280 (yours) 30% = \$120 to DTAWS
